升入五年级，同学们的英语学习又进入了一个新阶段。

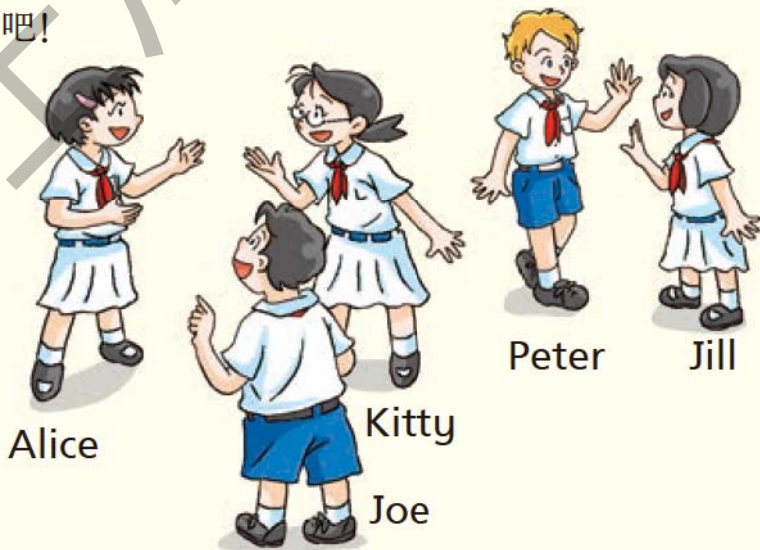
